

## **PHASE 3**

### **TTRS:**

Continue to engage in all TTRS activities documented in phases 1 & 2

Continue to build a support network outside of TTRS (natural and recovery supports)

Work on obtaining a driver's license (if applicable)

Have a service position through AA/NA

Continue to meal plan and practice grocery shopping skills

More in-depth planning around future housing arrangements

Make significant progress with step work

Take steps towards obtaining part-time employment or beginning college courses

Demonstrate increased parenting skills and routine

Obtain GED (if applicable)

Start steps to either attend school and/or become employed

Frequently interacts with CRMs inside and outside the house, continuing to have at least, 2 meaningful contacts with CRMs each week

### **Treatment:**

Actively engage in treatment and 1:1 sessions

Provide clean and testable UAs

Attend mental health appointments (if applicable)

### **DHS:**

Maintain good communication with DHS caseworker

Follow DHS safety plan

Engage in services referred by DHS, such as ISRS

Develop a plan for safe housing and support network upon completion of the TTRS program

**SSP:**

Maintain communication with SSP worker

Document/update schedule to reflect service hours

Attend JOBS activities to assist with resume building and job skills

Discuss goals and needed support for the goals
